Texas Motor Speedway is a 1.5 mile superspeedway, located between Fort Worth and Denton, attracting racing fans since 1997 and host of NASCAR races attended by 200,000-plus fans.

Fun Facts about Texas Motor Speedway:

How Enlightening: TMS has enough permanent lighting to illuminate 11 NFL stadiums — an average of 2,000,000 watts for a nighttime event. A standard household plug is 120 volts — the speedway lights run on 480 volts each.

By the Numbers: Approximately 60,000 — 70,000 vehicles are parked on speedway property for a NASCAR Sprint Cup Series race. A Cup race will also see 30,000 — 40,000 fans camping on the speedway grounds.
